TECHNIQUES FOR BLOOD COLLECTION ON FILTER PAPER

Laboratories Institute (CLSI) Blood Collection on Filter Paper for Newborn Screening Programs; Approved Standard - 5th Edition (CLSI LA4-A5)

Sampling Technique Collect the blood onto the labeled filter paper, using the following protocol: 1 Cleanse infant's heel with 70% isopropyl alcohol (use only rubbing alcohol)

Steps to Collecting the Newborn Screening Specimen

puncture site Allow blood to fill circle by natural flow Do not apply blood to both sides of the paper 7 Fill the first circle completely before moving on to the next circle Repeat procedure for each circle 8 Allow blood spots to air-dry at room temperature for at least three hours Keep away from direct light (sun or lamp) and heat 9

HOW TO COLLECT BLOOD SPOTS - PerkinElmer

Allow a drop of blood to form that will be large enough to fill the circle printed on the collection card Collect the blood on the rear side of the card only Make sure that blood fills the circle completely and saturates the paper right through Apply only once to each circle Do not layer Fill all of the circles with blood
